

October 7, 2015 **Refuse & Recycling Information**

**Automated Garbage Pick-up**

The Town of Cicero receives automated garbage pick-up. All garbage must fit inside the provided collection cart. Any other cans or bags of garbage will not be picked up.

If you would like an additional garbage cart you may request one, and you will be charged the annual refuse collection fee of \$124.50 per additional cart.

Original garbage carts will be replaced with new larger 95 gallon carts over the next several years. If you have problems with your cart, such as a broken wheel or lid call (920)833-7527 and it will be repaired or replaced at no cost.

**Guidelines:**

- \* Cart must be placed at the road before 6:00 A.M. on collection day.
- \* Place a minimum of 4 feet from recycling.
- \* Cart must be a minimum of 4 feet from other objects (mail box, signs, etc.).
- \* Place cart with handle facing your house.
- \* Do not place cart in the road way, place in driveway or on shoulder of road.
- \* Do not put heavy objects in the cart (household waste only).
- \* Do not put hazardous or illegal items in the cart.
- \* Do not put hot items in the cart.

**Recycling Collection**

Outagamie County provides free curbside recycling collection service to Cicero residents. Recycling is collected every other week on Tuesday's.

**Guidelines:**

- Reusable bins must not exceed 33 gallons and not weigh more than 50 pounds when set at the curb.
- Please mark your reusable bins with an Outagamie County Recycling Sticker, available upon request. Call (920) 968-5721 or email recycle@outagamie.org.
- Place all recyclable materials in your reusable bin. There is no need to separate paper from glass, aluminum, plastic and tin.
- Do not place recyclables in plastic bags and do not place trash in your recycling bin.
- All cardboard should be cut to no larger than 2 ft x 2 ft in size and secured on windy days.
- Shredded paper should be placed in a brown paper bag, stapled closed and placed in your bin/cart.
- Keep your reusable bin at least 4 ft away from your garbage cart. The best solution is to place garbage and recycling on opposite sides of your driveway.

**PLASTIC:**

**Accept**

All Plastic Bottles & Containers:  
Soda, Water & Other Drink Bottles  
Food & Household Bottles, Jars and Jugs  
Dairy Containers & Lids  
Produce, Bakery & Deli Containers

**Do Not Accept**

No Plastic Bags, Wrap or Film  
No Motor Oil Bottles  
No Styrofoam

**Guidelines:**

Empty and rinse all bottles and containers  
Remove and discard all screw caps

**PAPER:**

**Accept**

Newspapers & Inserts  
Cardboard & Paperboard (cereal & cracker boxes)

Junk Mail & Office Paper  
Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons  
Phonebooks, Books, Magazines & Catalogs

Do Not Accept  
No Paper Contaminated by Food or Grease  
No Tissue  
No Gift Wrap

Guidelines:  
Flatten and cut cardboard to no larger than 2' X 2'  
Place shredded paper in paper bag, secure and label

**METAL AND GLASS:**

Accept  
Aluminum Bottles & Cans  
Steel, Tin & Bi-metal Cans  
Empty Aerosol Cans  
Food & Beverage Glass Bottles and Jars

Do Not Accept  
No Aluminum Pans or Foil  
No Empty Paint Cans

Guidelines:  
Empty and rinse all bottles and containers  
Remove and discard all screw caps
