4.01 Ordinance to designate class "B" highways.

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Cicero Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Cicero, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under <u>s. 349.15 (2)</u>, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Cicero, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Cicero are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in <u>s. 348.16 (2)</u>, Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance:
 - 1. Grandy Road, from County Hwy F north to the Shawano County line
 - 2. Miller Road, from County Hwy G to State Hwy 54
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the weight limits set forth in $\underline{s.348.16}$ (2), Wis. stats. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under $\underline{s.348.21}$, Wis. stats.

Any previous ordinance for class B highways shall be voided upon passing of this ordinance.

This ordinance is effective on 501° 21, 2007. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under \underline{s} . 60.80, Wis. stats.
