4.04 Ordinance to designate heavy traffic routes and no thru truck routes

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Cicero Outagamie County

The Town Board of the Town of Cicero, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.17, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as heavy traffic routes in the town as follows:

- A. In this ordinance, "heavy traffic" means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles, other than motor buses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and having a gross weight of more than 6,000 pounds.
- B. The following Town of Cicero highways are designated as heavy traffic routes and heavy traffic on the following town highways is restricted or prohibited as follows:
 - 1) Deerview Road, between Hwy 47 and Grandy Rd. (No thru trucks)
 - 2) Miller Road, between Hwy 54 and Hwy G (No thru trucks)
- C. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- D. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the above-noted restrictions or prohibitions. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$500.00.

This ordinance is effective on April 20, 2016

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
